All Students Ready for School

During 2021-22, the school will conduct early childhood screenings on all students enrolled for kindergarten in the 2022-23 school year for whom the school can receive parent/guardian permission, and those who were not previously screened in another district. This data will be used to plan for needed interventions and classroom placements. The K-5 Assistant Special Education Coordinator will implement and monitor this.

All Students In Third Grade Achieving Grade Level Literacy

The percentage of third grade students enrolled on October 1 who score proficient or exceed on the reading MCA will increase from 47.6 percent in 2021 to 50.6 percent in 2022.

Close the Achievement Gap(s) Among All Groups

Growth of at least two percent from 2021 proficiency levels will occur in 50 percent of the school's reportable subgroups on the Minnesota Comprehensive Assessments.

All Students Career and College Ready by Graduation

All Junior Academy students (grades 6-8) will participate in a career interest survey and career readiness survey. During the 2021-22 academic year, at least 75 percent of our 8th grade students will meet with an administrator or counselor to discuss high school and career options. This will be tracked via a data sheet and completed by May 22.
